

**SUMMARY OF TELECONFERENCE MEETINGS
GADSDEN CITY COUNCIL
FEBRUARY 16, 2021**

The Gadsden City Council conducted a work session by teleconference at 10:00 a.m. on February 16, 2021. Council members Williams, Worthy, Back, Wilson, Cannon, and Reed were present. President Toles was absent. The council meeting agenda for February 16 was reviewed.

The Gadsden City Council met by teleconference at 11:00 a.m. on February 16, 2021. On roll call by the City Clerk, Iva Nelson, the following council members answered present: Williams, Worthy, Back, Wilson, Cannon, and Reed. President Toles was absent. The clerk stated a quorum was present and the meeting was open for business.

The council took the following actions:

- 1) Approved minutes of the work session and council meeting held on February 9, 2021
- 2) Ratified payment of the accounts for the week of February 5-11, 2021
- 3) Tabled a Resolution Ordering Abatement of Nuisances on property at 2441 Fairview Road in District 7 for an additional 30 days (had been tabled for 30 days on January 12)
- 4) Adopted Resolution No. R-21-21, Awarding Bid No. 3448 for 2021 Herbicide Application Project

Alicia Duck spoke regarding her work experience at Pilgrim's Pride and employee programs offered by the company.

John Reid (Reid Engineering) provided information regarding waste water pre-treatment relating to the proposed rendering plant.

Bob Sewell (Travis Trailers) described features of offal trailers used for transporting materials to and from rendering plants.

Dantez Robinson requested the city to allow family members to be present for commitment and graveside ceremonies at Forrest and Oakland (Alabama City) cemeteries.
