

ORDINANCE NO. O-04-10

Amending City Code Section 18-432 Regarding Plumbing Fees

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GADSDEN, ALABAMA, as follows:

Section 1. The Section 106.6.2 Fee Schedule provision in Section 18-432 of the Gadsden City Code is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 18-432. Amendments.

Section 106.6.2 Fee Schedule. The fees for all plumbing work shall be as indicated in the following schedule:

- (1) For issuing each permit, other than water heater replacement.....\$10.00
- (2) For issuing each permit for water heater replacement.....2.50
- (3) For each inspection (not a reinspection).....10.00
- (4) For first reinspection.....15.00
- (5) For second reinspection.....50.00
- (6) For third and each subsequent reinspection.....100.00

Plus the following when provided:

- (1) For each plumbing fixture, floor drain or trap (including water drainage piping and back flow protection thereof).....2.50
- (2) For each house sewer.....5.00
- (3) For each house sewer having to be replaced or repaired.....5.00
- (4) For each cesspool (where permitted).....5.00
- (5) For each septic tank and seepage pit or drainfield.....10.00
- (6) For each water heater and/or vent.....2.50
- (7) For installation, alteration or repair of water piping and/or water treating equipment, each.....5.00
- (8) For repair or alteration of drainage or vent piping, each fixture.....5.00
- (9) For vacuum breakers or backflow protective devices installed subsequent to the installation of the piping or equipment served, one to five.....2.50
- (10) Over five, each.....1.50

Section 2. A violation of this ordinance shall be punished as provided in Section 1-8 of the Gadsden City Code.

Section 3. The provisions of this ordinance shall be effective on publication.

Section 4. The sections, subsections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses and phrases of this ordinance are severable. If any section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause and phrase of this ordinance is declared unconstitutional or invalid by a valid judgment of a court of competent jurisdiction, such judgment shall not affect the validity of any other section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause and phrase of this ordinance. The city council declares that it is its intent that it would have enacted this ordinance without such invalid or unconstitutional provisions.

Section 5. The provisions of this ordinance repeal any prior ordinance or provision of the Gadsden City Code to the extent of any conflict. Section 18-333 is specifically repealed.
