

ORDINANCE NO. O-07-10

Amending City Code §34-4 Regarding Compensation of Election Officers

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GADSDEN, ALABAMA, that Section 34-4 of the Gadsden City Code is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 34-4. Compensation of election officers.

- (a) Each election clerk shall be paid \$75.00 per day for work holding a municipal election.
- (b) Each election inspector (who shall also serve as returning officer) shall be paid \$100.00 per day for work holding a municipal election.
- (c) Upon completion of a local election school or being certified as a qualified poll worker by the probate judge, or both, each clerk and inspector shall receive an additional \$25 per day.
- (d) If the State of Alabama or Etowah County increases the compensation paid to clerks and inspectors above the amounts provided in subsection (a)-(c), then the Mayor is authorized to increase the compensation payments to the amounts paid by the State or County.
