Player Identification

All players participating in the tournament must provide a picture I.D. (proof of age and picture). The I.D. check will be at Football Field at the Gadsden Sports Complex on Wednesday July 21st, from 4pm until 6 pm. Any team that does not attend the party and check-in must check in after opening ceremonies or at least 2 hours prior to game time.

Opening Ceremonies and Souvenir Swap

Opening Ceremonies will be held on Field 4 at the Gadsden Sports Complex. We would like for each team to bring a banner or signs to support your team. We do a pin or etc. exchanges at the Complex, we ask that each team bring something that's from your hometown so you can exchange with another team. We will let you know who you will exchange with at the coaches meeting. Please let us know if you are going to do the exchange by deadline or before. Thanks!

Game Ball

Official game ball will be Worth ASA approved

Line ups

There will be a table setup at the stairs, which is where you will do your coin toss. Please be at the table by the 5th inning of the game preceding your game or 15 minutes before your game which ever comes first, we will provide line up cards for each team, Home teams, as decided by coin toss, will sit in the first (1st) base dugout.

Uniforms

All players should wear uniforms alike in color, trim, and style. Coaches must be neatly attired and dressed alike or in team uniform and in accordance with team colors. (Please see rule 3, section 6 of ASA Code).

Coin Toss/ Home Team

The coin toss will be held in front of the Softball Complex tower at the bottom of the stairs; there will be a table set up for the coaches to come to do the coin toss, this will determine home team.

Player Passes

Each team member will be issued a player pass. There will also be four (4) Coaches passes per team. Theses are NOT transferable and will be monitored every time you enter the Complex.

Format

Pool Play then double elimination.

Dugout

Maximum allowed is 20 players, 4 coaches, 1 scorekeeper and 1 bat person. The Umpire will ask all unauthorized persons to leave the dugout.

Concessions

Concessions will run from start to finish at the Complex.

Team Tents

We do allow Team Tents in the Complex area; we just ask that they stay away from the stands behind the back stops.

Team Fans

Team fans are welcome as long as you have a generator. (No use of electricity in either Complex).

Souvenirs

National Tournament Shirts will be available on site during the tournament. A variety of souvenirs and Complex shirts can also be purchased.

Infield Practice

No infield practice is allowed. Please use the warm up areas. Teams wishing to practice may reserve a practice field by calling (256) 549-4710 from 8am-6pm.

Tournament Format

In accordance with ASA Regulation for Championship Tournament. Depending on the number of teams & weather conditions, this will determine the time of the last game. I would recommend that teams using commercial transportation to book their return passage for Monday following the tournament.

Rain Out / Tiebreaker

If there is a question concerning the weather, please call 256-549-4709 or 256-549-4710. In the event of rain or any cause which interrupts a game, the game must be resumed at the point in which it was stopped. It is the manager's responsibility to call the rain out number in such an event or visit the information table set up at the bottom of the steps near the tower at the Complex. If the tournament cannot be completed within the scheduled time frame and more than 40% of the games have been completed, then the official order of finish will be determined by team position in the bracket. Tiebreaker procedure will be as follows:

- Team which advance the farthest in the winner's bracket.
- Won – Loss Record
- If two teams are tied and have played each other, the winner of the game moves ahead.
- Fewest runs allowed per game played
- Most runs scored per game played
- Coin Toss

Tournament Photographer

During the tournament there will be a photographer on site for team pictures.

Awards

Team awards will be Championship, Runner-up, Third, Fourth and 2 Fifth Place, Championship Individual and Runner-up Individual.
