

**SUMMARY OF TELECONFERENCE MEETINGS  
GADSDEN CITY COUNCIL  
JANUARY 19, 2020**

The Gadsden City Council conducted a work session by teleconference at 10:00 a.m. on January 19, 2021. Council members Toles, Williams, Worthy, Back, Wilson, Cannon, and Reed were present. The council meeting agenda for January 19 was reviewed, as well as six potential resolutions for future consideration:

- 1) Resolution - Approving issuance of alcoholic beverage license to AJ Bravo, doing business as Don Bigotes, at 1729 Rainbow Drive
- 2) Resolution – Approving issuance of alcoholic beverage license to Express Motors Partnership GP, doing business as Express Mart 1, at 2511 S. 11<sup>th</sup> Street
- 3) Resolution – Approving issuance of alcoholic beverage license to Fresh Value Gadsden LLL, doing business as Fresh Value, at 2519 W. Meighan Boulevard
- 4) Resolution – Appointing members to Gadsden Cultural Arts Foundation, Inc.
- 5) Resolution – Authorizing tax abatement agreement with Koch Foods of Gadsden for major addition to its existing facility
- 6) Resolution – Authorizing agreement with Lexipol, LLC for professional services related to updating and certification of Gadsden Police Department Policies and Procedures

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The Gadsden City Council met by teleconference at 11:00 a.m. on January 19, 2021. On roll call by the City Clerk, Iva Nelson, the following council members answered present: Toles, Williams, Worthy, Back, Wilson, Cannon and Reed. The clerk stated a quorum was present and the meeting was open for business.

- 4) Adopted Resolution No. R-04-21, Authorizing 60-day extension of lease agreement with Gadsden Warehousing, Inc. for Building T-4, Sections A/B/C at Air Depot
- 5) Adopted Resolution No. R-05-21, Authorizing agreement with MLFLW, LLC in the amount of \$1,500 for Phoenix Bass Fishing League Bama Division Tournament at Coosa Landing on June 26, 2021
- 6) Adopted Resolution No. R-06-21, Authorizing tax abatement agreement with Koch Foods of Gadsden for major addition to its existing facility as an item of new business
- 7) Adopted Resolution No. R-07-21, Authorizing agreement with Lexipol, LLC for professional services related to updating and certification of Gadsden Police Department Policies and Procedures
