

**SUMMARY OF TELECONFERENCE MEETINGS  
GADSDEN CITY COUNCIL  
JANUARY 26, 2020**

The Gadsden City Council conducted a work session by teleconference at 10:00 a.m. on January 26, 2021. Council members Toles, Williams, Worthy, Back, Wilson, Cannon, and Reed were present. The council meeting agenda for January 26 was reviewed, as well as seven potential resolutions for future consideration:

- 1) Resolution - Appointing member to Zoning Board of Adjustment
- 2) Resolution – Appointing and reappointing members to Gadsden Commercial Development Authority
- 3) Resolution – Authorizing agreement in the amount of \$12,500 with Coosa River Team Trail to sponsor four fishing tournaments between March and October 2021, including two-day season finale tournament, at Coosa Landing
- 4) Resolution – Authorizing agreement in the amount of \$500 with Crappie Masters, Inc. to sponsor fishing tournaments on March 6 and May 22, 2021, at Coosa Landing
- 5) Resolution – Authorizing agreement in the amount of \$1,000 with American Bass Anglers, Inc. to sponsor fishing tournament on June 12, 2021, at Coosa Landing
- 6) Resolution – Authorizing month-to-month lease agreement with Dairyman’s Supply Company for property at Air Depot for \$4,000 per month
- 7) Resolution – Authorizing nondisturbance agreement with Gadsden OPCO, LLC and Bank of America, N.A. regarding sale of Buffalo Wild Wings Restaurant

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The Gadsden City Council met by teleconference at 11:00 a.m. on January 26, 2021. On roll call by the City Clerk, Iva Nelson, the following council members answered present: Toles, Williams, Worthy, Back, Cannon and Reed. Councilman Wilson joined the meeting shortly after it began. The clerk stated a quorum was present and the meeting was open for business.

Deborah Gaither, Emergency Management Agency Director, provided an update concerning COVID-19 statistics and vaccinations.

The council took the following actions:

- 3) Noted no council action was necessary regarding a Resolution Ordering Abatement of Nuisances on property at 507 Cherry Street in District 5, since the nuisance was abated by the owner
- 4) Conducted a Public Hearing (no one spoke) and adopted Resolution No. R-08-21, Approving issuance of restaurant retail liquor license to AJ Bravo, LLC, doing business as Don Bigotes, at 1729 Rainbow Drive
- 5) Conducted a Public Hearing (no one spoke) and adopted Resolution No. R-09-21, Approving issuance of retail beer and table wine, off premises only, license to Express Motors Partnership GP, doing business as Express Mart 1, at 2511 S. 11<sup>th</sup> Street
- 6) Conducted a Public Hearing (no one spoke) and adopted Resolution No. R-10-21, Approving issuance of retail beer and table wine, off premises only, license to Fresh Value Gadsden, LLC, doing business as Fresh Value, at 2519 W. Meighan Boulevard
- 7) Adopted Resolution No. R-11-21, Appointing members to Gadsden Cultural Arts Foundation, Inc.
- 8) Adopted Resolution No. R-12-21, Appointing member to Zoning Board of Adjustment as an item of new business
- 9) Adopted Resolution No. R-13-21, Authorizing month-to-month lease agreement with Dairyman’s Supply Company for property at Air Depot for \$4,000 per month as an item of new business
- 10) Adopted Resolution No. R-14-21, Authorizing nondisturbance agreement with Gadsden OPCO, LLC and Bank of America, N.A. regarding sale of Buffalo Wild Wings Restaurant as an item of new business
